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School and Community

The International School of Kenya (ISK) is a non-profit, PreK-12, coeducational, independent day school serving the expatriate and Kenyan communities in Nairobi. The school was started by the United States Embassy and the Canadian High Commission in 1976 and is fully accredited by the Middle States Association of Colleges and Schools and the Council of International Schools. Approximately 43% of the school's 1,052 students are North Americans, and the remainder represent over 65+ other nationalities.

The High School faculty is composed of 36 full and 5 part time professionals. 44% of the faculty are North Americans, 100% have a bachelor's degree and 96% have advanced degrees. The first semester begins in August and ends in December. The second semester begins in January and ends in June. The High School operates a schedule that includes eight blocks.


Each block in 9th and 10th grade meets five times in a typical twoweek period, with each block being 80 minutes in length. For 11th and 12th graders our student schedules provide the recommended hours for each IB standard and higher level subject and respects concurrency of learning. There are 36 weeks (180 days) in the school year. All ISK students are required to complete an Intercultural trip, a service project and a creative and activity program each year of high school.

Starting in grade 9 in 2021-22, the high school introduced a Life-Centered Education program leading to an alternative high school diploma.

Credits and Graduation Requirements

In grades 9 through 12, one credit is awarded for each one-year ISK course completed with a passing mark of 3 or above. One half credit is earned for one semester. A minimum of 24 credits is required for graduation. Students transferring to ISK from another school may bring in a maximum of 8 credits per year.

COVID-19 Disruption

In the 2019-2020 school year, ISK moved to virtual learning from March 23 through the end of the school year. Students continued to receive grades but were largely unable to participate in extracurricular activities. All sports, performances, and other gatherings were prohibited.

For the 2020-2021 school year, the ISK High School started the academic year in virtual learning starting from September 1, 2020. On October 26, 2020, students in grades 11 and 12 returned to campus for in-person learning. In January, students in grades 9 and 10 joined on campus, in-person learning. Grades 11 and 12 returned to virtual learning for a week from March 1 through March 7, 2021. Grades 9 and 10 remained on campus for learning in that time period. On March 22, 2021, ISK went to virtual learning for all grades and returned to campus for in-person learning on May 10, 2021 through the end of the academic year. All sports, performances and other gatherings were reintroduced following ISK Covid safety measures. Intercultural trips were cancelled.

For the 2021-2022 school year, ISK returned to on campus, in-person learning with extracurricular activities following safety protocols. Intercultural trips were postponed to the second semester.

For the 2022-2023 school year, ISK returned to on campus, in-person learning and Covid 19 restrictions have been lifted. Extracurricular activities returned with minimal restrictions.

STEM/Arts Pathway Courses

ISK's Pathways courses are an independent study aimed at selfmotivated, creative thinking, high achieving students passionately interested in the STEM and/or the Arts. These are standards based courses designed to provide students with opportunities for experiential, personalized and integrated learning.


In STEM Pathways, students navigate the messiness of the creative process from inception to completion by prototyping and testing and integrating science, mathematics and technology. The focus is to identify and engineer a solution to solve a real world problem of global significance. The Design Cycle is used as the framework for their process journal / portfolio documentation which is also the major assessment component together with a final presentation at the end of the course.

In Arts Pathways, students have the opportunity to either work across combinations of the 3 disciplines, Music, Theatre & Visual Arts respectively, or to focus more specifically within one or two Arts subjects. Students design an individual Creative Learning Plan outlining their artistic intentions and goals. The course provides the opportunity to extend and deepen their application portfolio work. A final presentation is also required, and assessed, as a culminating activity appropriately designed in accordance to an individual student's artistic intentions and portfolio.

ISK Course Rigor and Honors Courses

ISK courses are designed to prepare students for the rigor of university level academics. IB courses at ISK are recognized as Honors courses. In addition, students who meet the requirements of an IB course but do not complete all components of the IB course (e.g., sitting the final IB exam papers) will have 'Honors' (instead of 'IB') recorded on their transcript for the title of that course. Given that there may be little difference in the academic rigor and assessment expectations of the IB and Honors-only versions of a course, Honors-only students are expected to complete all IB assignments and IA's (in some cases, IA's can be adjusted in consultation with the teacher to meet the standard of an Honors-only as opposed to an IB examination course).

Creativity, Activity, Service & Leadership (CASL) Program

The CASL program provides a meaningful framework for co-curricular activities for students to initiate and reflect upon sustainable community projects that are mutually beneficial and cultivate personal and community growth. All students are required to complete annual projects in the areas of creativity, activity, service and leadership followed by self-evaluation and reflection.

THE IB PROGRAM AT ISK

The International Baccalaureate (IB) Diploma
Program at ISK provides high school students
with a diploma and certificates recognized by
universities throughout the world. Students may
enrol in the full IB Diploma Program, requiring
six externally administered exams, Extended
Essay, and Theory of Knowledge course, or they
may also take specific individual IB courses for
IB certificates. The maximum score possible in
each IB course is 7. All IB courses are a two-year
sequence. ISK has an inclusive policy in regards to
the IB Diploma Program; it is open to all students
who satisfactorily complete prerequisite courses.
