



Academic Honesty IB Candidate Consent Form

This Academic Honesty form is designed to define and clarify the expectations associated with the submission of authentic work. Academic misconduct primarily refers to the practice of deceit when completing work, normally in order to gain an unfair advantage for self or others (e.g., in order to enhance a grade). Acts of academic misconduct that do not meet expectations include but are not limited to:

- Giving or receiving aid that has not been approved by the teacher on or for any assessments
- Using unauthorized assistance by an external tutor for assessments
- Using outside materials on an assessment, except when authorized by a teacher
- Unauthorized prior possession (including pre-viewing or being informed about in any format) of assessment materials or taking unauthorized material into an examination/assessment
- Fabricating or falsifying data, citations or other information
- Paraphrasing another person's story or the repetition of critical judgments without credit
- Using the words, ideas, images or writings of another without crediting the source (aka plagiarism).
- Re-submitting the same or substantially similar work for which a grade/credit has already been given (aka duplication).
- Copying or tampering with the academic work of others
- Facilitating another's academic misconduct, for example, providing other students with homework answers, assessment answers, original or photocopied essays, and related activities (aka collusion)

IB coordinators are expected to collect a signature from each individual IB candidate who is submitting work to the International Baccalaureate Organization. This declaration will cover <u>all</u> pieces of work produced and provided by the IB candidate, including all internally and externally assessed work.

Declaration

I understand and consent to:

- 1. The IB coordinator or another authorized school staff member uploading my work to the IB's eCoursework system, and
- 2. The IB's processing, use, disclosure, and transfer of my personal data, including without limitation any sensitive personal data and/or education records, as described in the IB's privacy policy and the Privacy Supplement, including worldwide cross-border transfers (including storage and access of such data outside of your country of residence).

I confirm that

- 1. I am at least 15 years old;
- that the version of any materials I pass to the IB coordinator or another school staff member is the correct and final version, is my own work and that I have correctly acknowledged the work of others, and
- 3. that failure to do this will be investigated as a potential breach of IB regulations.
